Call to Order

The April 3, 2017, organizational meeting for GO Virginia Region 8 was called to order by Carrie Chenery, Executive Director of the Shenandoah Valley Partnership (SVP) at 10:05 a.m.

Welcome & Introductions

All Council members introduced themselves.

Statewide GO Virginia Overview

Ben Davenport, Vice Chair of the statewide Virginia Growth and Opportunity Board, provided overview comments and a detailed presentation to all Council members and meeting attendees.

Regional GO Virginia Overview

Existing organizations collaborating on GO Virginia in the Shenandoah Valley provided an overview of their mission and roles in this new initiative. These presentations were given by:

- Bonnie Riedesel, Executive Director, Central Shenandoah Planning District Commission
- Brandon Davis, Executive Director, Northern Shenandoah Valley Regional Commission
- Carrie Chenery, Executive Director, Shenandoah Valley Partnership
- Sharon Johnson, CEO, Shenandoah Valley Workforce Development Board

This group presented a collaborative approach to staffing the GO Virginia Region 8 Council, which would follow this model for the region:

- The Shenandoah Valley Partnership (SVP) will remain the face/voice of GOVA for the region, staff the Council, organize Board meetings, and advise the Council on regional projects
- The Northern Shenandoah Valley Regional Commission (NSVRC) will handle all money from DHCD and track spending, performance metrics, audit requirements, etc.
- The Central Shenandoah Planning District Commission (CSPDC) will run the G&D plan as appropriate
- The Shenandoah Valley Workforce Development Board (SVWDB) will be on standby to administer any workforcerelated projects approved by the Regional Council
- Once a budget is approved, the NSVRC will transfer some level of funding to SVP for administrative assistance, and to the CSPDC for any associated plan costs, in addition to retaining whatever will be needed for their fiscal due diligence support

Dr. John Downey made a motion to approve this staff structure, and President Jon Alger seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously with Council members agreeing to this approach for staffing.

Governance

Draft Bylaws were presented to the Council based on a model provided by the Department of Housing & Community Development (DHCD) for regional councils. These bylaws were approved unanimously by the Council after a motion for approval by Connie Loughhead and a second by Keith May.

Nominations were solicited for both Chair and Vice Chair of the Region 8 GO Virginia Council. Robin Sullenberger nominated George Pace to Chair the Council, and Dennis Morris seconded the nomination. The motion carried unanimously. Keith May nominated Chris Kyle to serve as Vice Chair of the Council, and John King seconded the nomination, with the motion carrying unanimously.

Four sub-committees were proposed by Chairman George Pace, to include:

- 1. Nominating Committee
- 2. Growth and Diversification Plan Committee
- 3. Grant Proposals Study and Review Committee
- 4. Executive Committee

Council members were asked to submit requests for their sub-committee participation by April 14th. Joanie Eiland made a motion to approve the creation of these four sub-committees, and John Downey seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Council members were reminded of their obligations and coverage under the Freedom of Information Act and Conflicts of Interest Act for service on this Council, with more information expected to come from the state on the particulars of these requirements for each regional council.

Planning

The Council reviewed a series of important planning processes, including preparation for a regional Growth and Diversification, a full planning calendar for council activities and state deadlines for the year, and a short-term budget proposal.

Next Steps

The Council agreed to form sub-committees following the April 14th deadline for assignment requests. Each subcommittee will select its Chair at its first meeting.

Council members were encouraged to attend a statewide orientation session to be held in Richmond, Virginia, on April 20th for all regional council members and support organizations across the Commonwealth.

In advance of the next meeting, staff was assigned to distribute a Request for Proposals (RFP) for a Growth and Diversification Plan Consultant.

Next Council Meeting

Chairman Pace suggested a next meeting of the Council on May 23rd, and Carrie Chenery notified the Council that she would work with partners in the region to host this meeting in the Northern end of the Valley, with all future meetings rotating throughout the region.

Public Comment

Patricia Higgins with James Madison University provided brief public comments about collaborating in the region with higher education.

Adjournment

There being no further business to come before the Council, Chairman Pace adjourned the meeting at 11:47 a.m.
